Moldova Updates

Creative Evangelism

Our Latest Project

Hello and greetings from Zagreb! This past month has been amazing — full of faith-building experiences and open conversations. It's been a season of sowing, as our team has been going out almost every day, two by two, to share our faith across different campuses in the city.

One of the most encouraging encounters I've had happened at the Faculty of Economics and Business. My partner and I met a student on his way to an exam. He was interested but didn't have much time, so we exchanged contacts and wished him luck. About half an hour later, while we were still sharing nearby, he came back and asked if we could talk more about God. We sat down for twenty minutes, and he told us how he'd grown up culturally Christian but had only recently begun seeking God—about three months ago. He said his Instagram feed had suddenly been filled with videos about faith and the Bible, and then two missionaries stopped him on campus. He was amazed. It was clear that God was already pursuing him long before we met.

It's amazing to witness how well this team has come together after only a couple of months. It really feels like we're becoming a true spiritual family.
